4 Ways to Cancel Coverage for an Employee

If you've recently had to terminate an employee's employment, and that employee participated in your Allied National health plan, there are a few different ways you can handle removing that person from your company's coverage.



Your options include:

1. Completing the section on the back of your monthly bill showing the employee number, employee name and a reason for cancelling coverage. If employment was terminated, you'll need to provide the last day worked. You'll next want to deduct the current monthly charge for that insured's premium amount if appropriate. Only deduct premium if the employee wasn't eligible for coverage for the month being billed. If any refund might be due, it will be applied on the next billing cycle.
2. Faxing the notification to attention Underwriting at 913-945-4397.
3. Emailing the notification to underwriting@alliednational.com.
4. Logging into your Self-Service Site and request employee termination.

Whichever communication route you choose, you'll need to provide the reason for cancelling coverage. If his/her employment has ended, you also will need to provide the last day worked. If the employee is still considered an eligible employee, you must complete a waiver form for that employee.

As a reminder, if an employee works even one day of the month, then that employee is eligible for coverage for that month.
