

Overland Park, Kan. – Lisa Hodson is the new Chief Executive Officer of Allied National, a third-party administrator of self-funded group health benefits and individual plans.

Hodson assumed responsibilities on Jan. 2 and succeeds Bill Ashley who will serve in a newly designed role as Executive Vice President focusing on business development. Joining Allied in 2017, Hodson was promoted to Chief Strategy and Development Officer in 2020; and to Executive Vice President overseeing marketing and sales in 2022. Hodson previously worked as Chief Strategy Officer for GEHA, the second-largest national health plan serving federal employees, federal retirees and their families. Prior to this position, she served as Vice President of Global Project Services and as Director of the Project Management Office at GEHA.
